RACE CONTROL NOTIFICATION SYSTEM (RCNS)

INSTRUCTIONS

PURPOSE:

The Race Control Notification System (RCNS), is a web-based application that provides a communication channel between Race Control and Teams (similar to instant messenger).

IMPORTANT: SEE THE IMSA OFFICIALS AT THE IMSA PIT CART FOR ASSISTANCE.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- RCNS is used in a web browser. **Google Chrome is recommended.**
- RCNS is only available on the pit lane network
- Username/Password are available below or at the IMSA Pit Cart

1. INITIAL SET UP:

1.1. Router Setup.

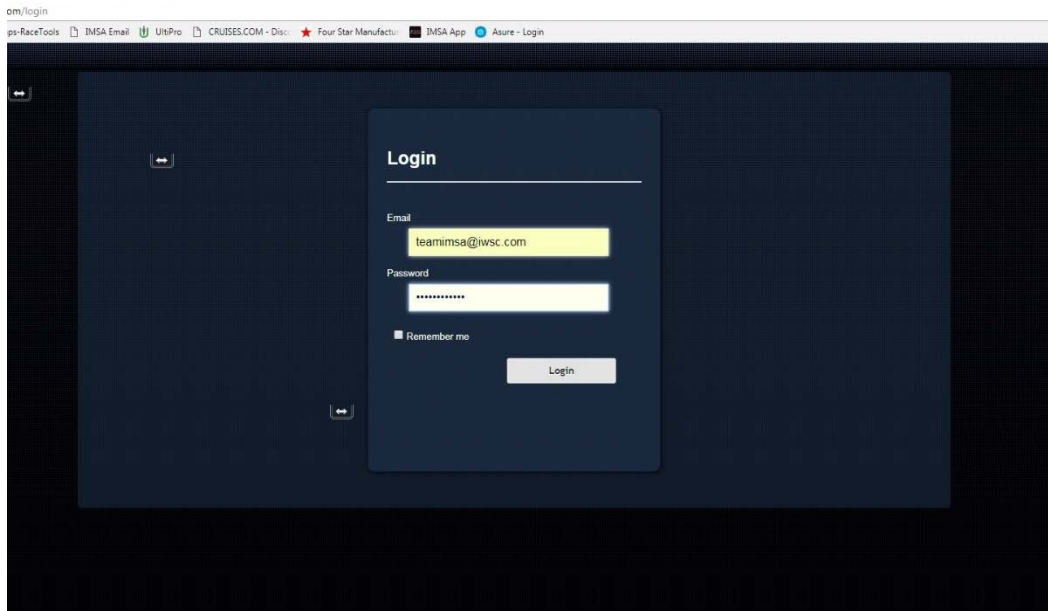
If using an additional router with the IMSA router or the IMSA router is not the default gateway (192.168.0.1), a static route must be added. Please add the static route 192.168.74.0/24 and direct to the IMSA router (192.168.0.1).

1.2. Initial Log In.

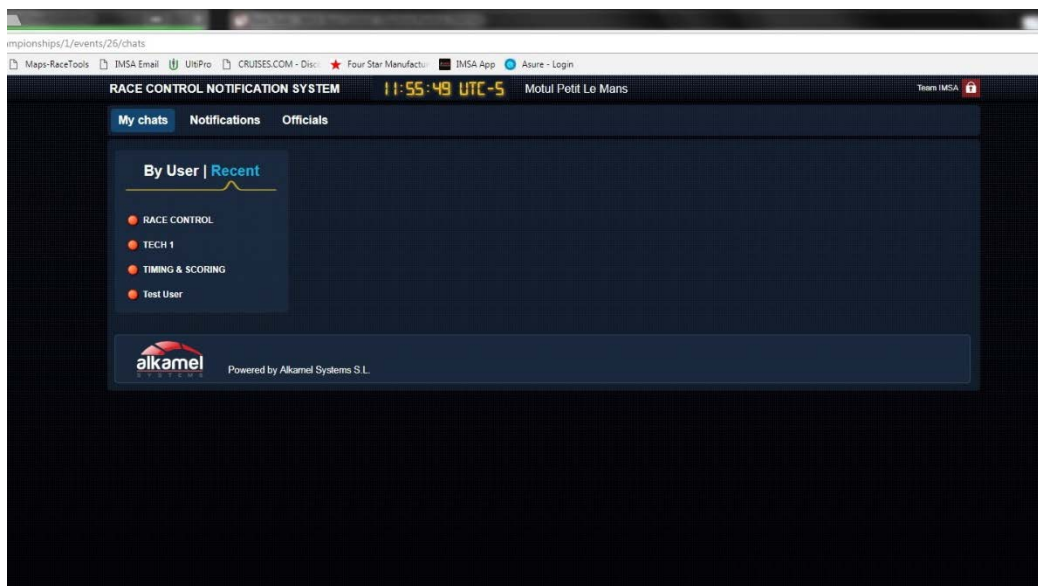
Open Google Chrome and go to <http://rcns.aks.com>. A login screen will appear. Your credentials are:

Once you login with the credentials provided you will see User Names on the left side of the screen:



RACE CONTROL is used for communication to the Race Director. Use this Chat to report on-track activity, passes under yellow and similar incidents. **All reports must include time of day, location and a description of the specific concern.** Vague reports receive lower priority.

- Passes under yellow must be reported only via IM, not through pit lane officials.
- Requests to go behind the wall must be made through the pit officials, not IM

TECH1 is used during WeatherTech sessions only to communicate with the Technical Department.

MICHELIN is used to communicate with the Michelin pit cart on pit lane.

TIMING & SCORING is used to contact Timing & Scoring for any Driver ID related questions, including incorrect driver on timing screen. **Timing & Scoring does not answer questions about other Competitors.**
